What is the solution?

For the use of researchers and scholars in the field working with datasets, these recommendations propose components of data citation for referencing language data, both in the bibliography and in the text of linguistics publications.

The recommendations are intended to be guidelines rather than strict rules, and are based on the Austin Principles, the FORCE11 and Research Data Alliance Joint Declaration of Data Citation Principles, and the Reproducible Research in Linguistics position statement

What is the impact?

Provides guidance for citing linguistic data in publications to researchers, academic publishers and resource providers.
