## What is the impact?

The comparison guide and checklist can be used by countries at any stage on the journey to developing a national PID strategy. This is supported by the nine case studies collected from Australia, Canada, Czech Republic, Finland, Germany, the Netherlands, New Zealand, South Korea, and the United Kingdom. A template has been provided so that other countries can submit their case studies to the National PID Strategies Interest Group.
