1. Education

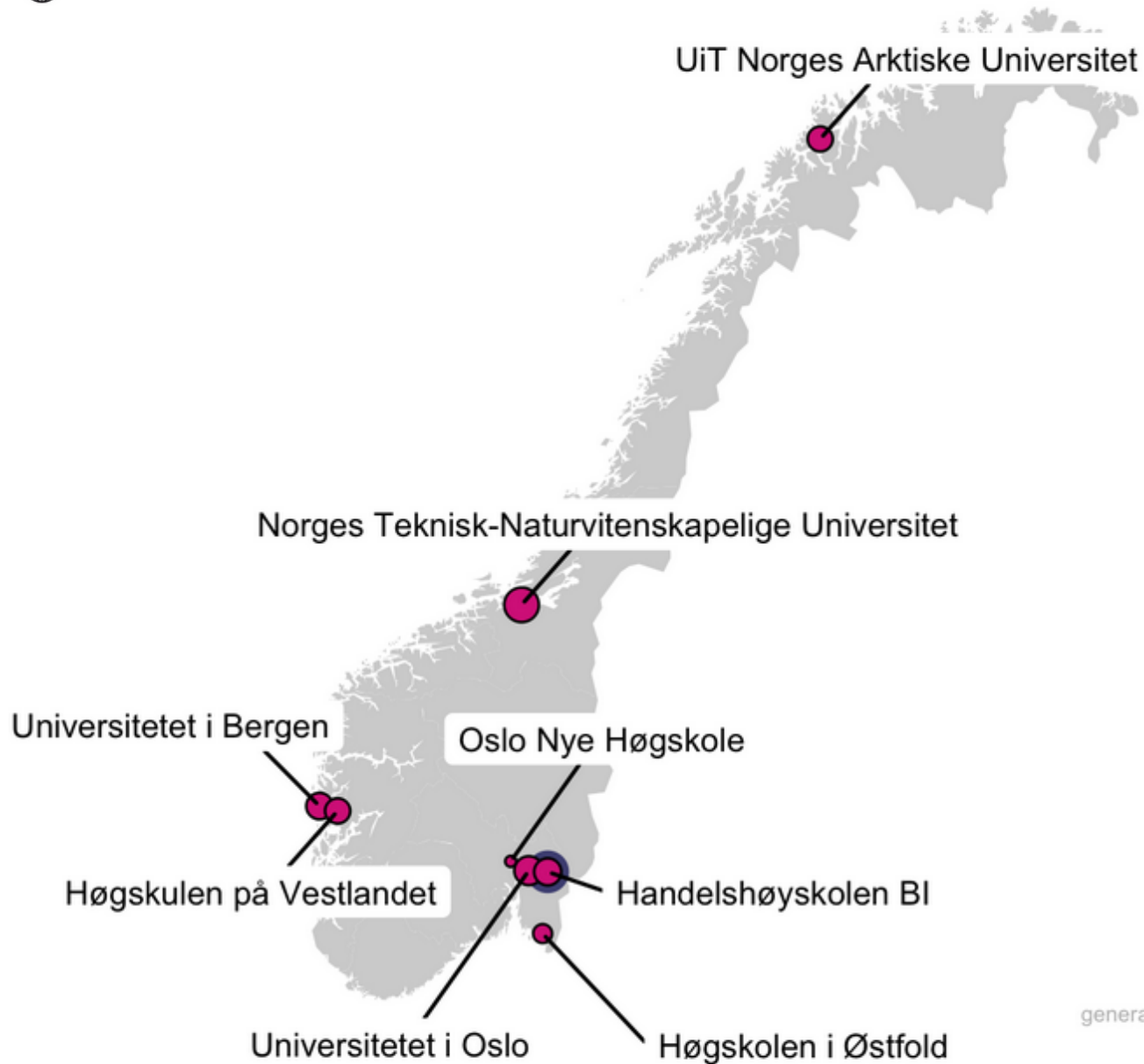
designing and establishing appropriate training activities

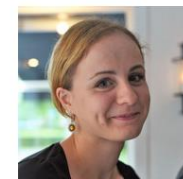
